### **AISC Code of Conduct**

### 1. Scope

All members (financial and playing) of Auckland Indian Sports Club (A.I.S.C.) hereafter referred to as the "club" shall abide to the following rules hereafter referred to as the "Code of Conduct".

#### 2. Provisions

2.1 Members shall not engage in any Unacceptable Behaviour during any occasion where they are supporting or representing the club.

The following provide examples of "Unacceptable Behaviour" but are in no way intended to completely define the term. The A.I.S.C. Judiciary will retain the authority to determine what constitutes "Unacceptable Behaviour" on a case-by-case basis.

- 2.1.1 Assaulting or threatening to assault an umpire, match referee, another player or any official, at any time.
- 2.1.2 Abuse or use of crude or offensive language, during any event or fixture.
- 2.1.3 Any conduct detrimental to the standards upheld by the club, or which may otherwise cause harm to the reputation of the club.
- 2.1.4 Assault, threaten to assault or abuse a spectator at any event or fixture.
- 2.1.5 Cause wilful damage to property of any nature.
- 2.1.6 Solicit or use drugs or any other illegal substances or any substances which are banned by governing bodies of sports codes.
- 2.1.7 Engage in theft, fraudulent activity, misappropriation of monies or similar misdemeanour.
- 2.2 Members shall not infringe the club rules, written or verbal, relating to: sponsorship and or advertising on clothing and or equipment.
- 2.3 Members shall not engage in any act, omission or conduct, prejudicial to the interests of the club and or bring any member into disrepute.
- 2.4 Members must observe venue and or event rules and or instructions of the management at all times.
- 2.5 Members shall abide by the dress code in the participating sport and play in club strip or approved and appropriate apparel.
- 2.6 Wilful damage or theft of club gear or uniform by members will constitute a breach of the Code of Conduct.

2.7 Members shall not make any announcement or media comment without prior consent of the Club Committee.

Breach of this Code of Conduct may result in immediate suspension from participation in and or attendance at club events and be subject to other disciplinary action to be resolved by the Judicial Committee of the club. Such actions may include match suspension and or fines.

The executive committee has the authority to adjudicate on any other breaches that not be specifically covered by the above code of conduct for members or non-members who may otherwise wish to participate in other club activities.

Offending members will be required to attend the judicial hearing.

# PENALTIES FOR BREACH OF A.I.S.C. CODE OF CONDUCT

## SCALE OF PENALTY (FOR JUDICIAL COMMITTEE ONLY)

	Offence	Punishment
1.	Disputing an umpires or referees decision, serious reluctance to accept decisions, use of lewd gestures.	1 match and / or fine
2.	Abuse of an umpire / referee (in cases of extreme abuse, a further penalty may be applied).	2 matches and / or fine
3.	Persistent or deliberate breach of the rules of any sport that members are attending as supporters, players, or officials, e.g. Cricket, Hockey, Golf, Rugby and others, following a warning from the match umpire/referee.	
4.	Acts detrimental to the club, e.g. misbehaviour, abuse of equipment / buildings / property / theft or other misdemeanour.	
5.	Abuse and / or assaulting conduct with a spectator.	2 matches and / or fine
6.	Deliberately striking a player, or a spectator with any equipment that could be considered a weapon.	2-8 matches and / or fine
7.	Assault or battery of a player, spectator, umpire / referee or official.	4 matches to life
8.	Soliciting in or the use of drugs or any other illegal substances.	8 matches to life
9.	Bringing the club reputation into disrepute.	2-8 matches

### Notes:

- 1. The Judicial Committee will consist of 3 members to be appointed by the club.
- 2. The Judicial Committee retains the authority to impose, monitor and / or alter any penalty it hands down as it sees fit.
